



ORDINANCE NO 2 4 5 7
INTRODUCED BY Norberg

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRANCHISE BY THE CITY OF THORNTON TO PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF COLORADO, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE NONEXCLUSIVE RIGHT TO FURNISH, SELL AND DISTRIBUTE GAS AND ELECTRICITY TO THE CITY AND TO ALL PERSONS, BUSINESSES, AND INDUSTRY, WITHIN PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY'S SERVICE AREA, WITHIN THE CITY AND THE RIGHT TO ACQUIRE, CONSTRUCT, INSTALL, LOCATE, MAINTAIN, OPERATE AND EXTEND INTO, WITHIN AND THROUGH SAID CITY ALL FACILITIES REASONABLY NECESSARY TO FURNISH, SELL AND DISTRIBUTE GAS AND ELECTRICITY WITHIN THE CITY AND THE NONEXCLUSIVE RIGHT TO MAKE REASONABLE USE OF ALL STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES, AS HEREIN DEFINED, AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO THE EXERCISE OF SAID RIGHT, AND FIXING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THEREOF THESE RIGHTS SHALL EXTEND TO ALL AREAS OF THE CITY, WITHIN PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY'S SERVICE AREA, AS IT IS NOW CONSTITUTED AND TO ANY ADDITIONAL AREAS ANNEXED BY THE CITY, WITHIN PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY'S SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, Public Service Company of Colorado ("PSCo") provides gas and electricity within the corporate boundaries of the City of Thornton ("City"); and

WHEREAS, PSCo has filed an application with the City requesting the City grant a non-exclusive gas and electric franchise to it, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 15 of the Charter of the City provides that all franchises shall be granted only by ordinance after a public hearing, and

WHEREAS, PSCo and the City have negotiated a franchise agreement which grants PSCo a franchise upon terms and conditions contained therein

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THORNTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS

1 The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, this ordinance thereby granting Public Service Company of Colorado a franchise pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the Public Service Company Franchise Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as Exhibit A

2 This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and upon the filing of an unconditional acceptance of all terms of the Public Service Company Franchise Agreement by Public Service Company of Colorado
