AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRANCHISE BY THE CITY OF THORNTON TO UNITED POWER, INC OF COLORADO, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, A NONEXCLUSIVE RIGHT TO FURNISH, SELL AND DISTRIBUTE ELECTRICITY TO THE CITY AND TO ALL PERSONS, BUSINESSES AND INDUSTRY, WITHIN UNITED POWER'S SERVICE AREA, WITHIN THE CITY AND THE RIGHT TO ACQUIRE, CONSTRUCT, INSTALL, LOCATE, MAINTAIN, OPERATE AND EXTEND INTO, WITHIN AND THROUGH SAID CITY ALL FACILITIES REASONABLY NECESSARY TO FURNISH, SELL AND DISTRIBUTE ELECTRICITY WITHIN THE CITY AND A NONEXCLUSIVE RIGHT TO MAKE REASONABLE USE OF ALL STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES, AS HEREIN DEFINED, AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO THE EXERCISE OF SAID RIGHT, AND FIXING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THEREOF. THESE RIGHTS SHALL EXTEND TO ALL AREAS OF THE CITY, WITHIN UNITED POWER'S SERVICE AREA, AS IT IS NOW CONSTITUTED AND TO ANY ADDITIONAL AREAS ANNEXED BY THE CITY, WITHIN UNITED POWER'S SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, United Power, Inc. provides electricity to properties within the corporate boundaries of the City of Thornton, and

WHEREAS, United Power, Inc. has filed an application with the City of Thornton, Colorado, requesting the City grant a non-exclusive electric franchise to it; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 15 of the Charter of the City of Thornton provides that all franchises shall be granted only by ordinance after a public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THORNTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the Electric Utility Franchise Ordinance attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final passage and upon the filing of an unconditional acceptance of all terms of the electric franchise ordinance by United Power, Inc
