| Audible Alert Smoke Detectors | The City of Thornton Fire Department provides smoke detectors free of charge to low-income senior, disabled, or indigent persons (while supplies last). | Home Repair Programs | The City of Thornton Neighborhood Services Division offers the Help for Homes and Rebuilding Days programs to Thornton residents 55 and older or disabled persons. Qualified applicants must own and live in their home and meet income guidelines. Typical activities include wheelchair ramps, installing grab bars, light plumbing and electrical repair. | Safety of Seniors Handyman Program | Volunteers of America (VOA) provide home repair and improvement services to seniors. Materials and labor are free of charge for first time clients, return clients only pay for materials. VOA also sponsors annual events such as Rake up Colorado (a leaf raking and removal event) and Cool Down Colorado (distribution of fans and carbon monoxide detectors). | Call 303-297-0408 or go to www.voacolorado.org |
