HISTORY: (includes previous City Council action)

Bob Lloyd began his employment with the City on February 17, 1987 as an Evidence Technician/Crime Scene Investigator and was promoted to Senior Criminalist on September 1, 2000. Other achievements include:

- Twenty two (22) years with the Thornton Police Department holding positions of Evidence Technician/Crime Scene Investigator and Senior Criminalist
- Twenty (20) years as a police officer with Detroit, Michigan Police Department
- Selected to present a paper at the FBI Academy in Quantico, Virginia, on "Crime Scene Documentation and Reconstruction"; also, authored an article published in the November 1994 issue of Law and Order
- Has provided very valuable instruction to members of the Thornton Police Department and other agencies
- Is a member of the Adams County Critical Incident Team
- Assisted numerous agencies in homicide investigations
- Received Employee of the Month awards in July 1990, April 1992, and November 2006
- Was nominated for Employee of the Year in 1992
- Received a Distinguished Service Award in June 1994 for his work on the Maloney Case
- Served on the Department Focus Group in 1995-1996
- Received Unit Citations in January 1991, January 1999, April 1999, December 1999, October 2003, June 2005, and February 2006
- Served on the Department Awards Board from 2006-2007 and 2008-2009
- Received numerous letters of appreciation for his work on several serious assault and homicide crime scenes
- Has provided several instructional blocks of training for the Citizens Academy
- Assisted with providing information for the 2002 Concerns of Police Survivors manual

WHEREAS, Bob Lloyd has provided valuable instruction and mentoring to members of the Thornton Police Department and other agencies; and

WHEREAS, Bob Lloyd served as an integral member of the Adams County Critical Incident Team; and

WHEREAS, Bob Lloyd received Employee of the Month awards in July 1990, April 1992, and November 2006 and was nominated for Employee of the Year in 1992; and

WHEREAS, Bob Lloyd received a Distinguished Service Award for his work on the Rhonda Maloney homicide case in 1994; and

WHEREAS, Bob Lloyd received numerous memos and letters of appreciation for his job performance and assistance to other agencies; and

WHEREAS, Bob Lloyd has approached his job in a professional, skillful, and dedicated manner, and with a strong commitment to serve the community; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to recognize Bob Lloyd for the outstanding contributions he has made over his years of service to the City of Thornton.
