Mr. McCain participated in critical land use and development decisions including: Village 88 Clubhouse, Old Chicago Restaurant, Caring Hands Animal Hospital, Cherrywood Park and Thornton Town Center Compass Banks, Country Hills Mountain Fitness, Autumn Creek Self-Storage, Country Hills Trinity Medical Center, View Point Liquors, Cottonwood Lakes Medical Center, Alternative Auto Care, as well as numerous residential developments, cell towers, oil and gas wells and remodels.
