Thornton's Infrastructure Maintenance Center, 12450 Washington St., Use the IMC's north entrance with access on 126th Avenue east of Washington Street.

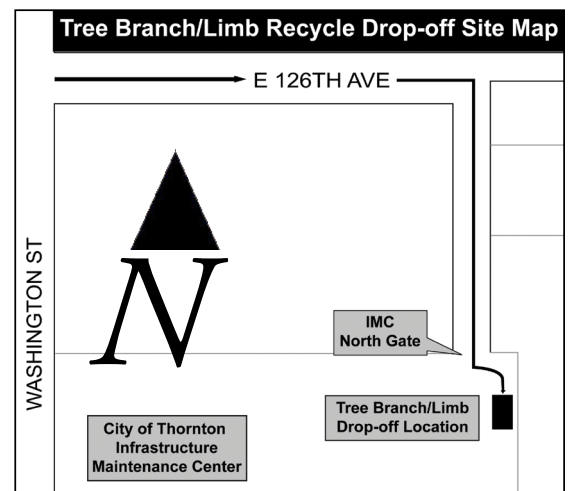
Dates:

March 10, April 14, May 12, June 9, July 14, August 11, September 8, October 13.

10 a.m. - 2 p.m.

Eligible for drop-off:

Tree branches and limbs up to eight-inches in diameter.



Guidelines

Proof of residency is required (driver's license and/or City utility bill)

Car, pickup or single axle trailers (4'W X 4'H X 8'L) only.

Loads must be covered.

You will be responsible for unloading your branches, etc.

The City of Thornton reserves the right to reject any items or service.

Self loading mulch may be made available and while supplies last.

Program drop-off restricted to dates and times listed.

Restrictions

No root balls or tree stumps.

No branches larger than eight inches in diameter.

No branches longer than six feet in length.

No insect infested branches.

No grass clippings, leaves, sod, dirt or other green waste.

No construction lumber or treated lumber.

No trash or plastic bags.

No commercial or landscaping companies.
