Latex base can be dried and placed in normal household trash. Oil-based paint can be dropped off at the Household Hazardous Chemical Roundup.

Contact Tri-County Health Dept. at 303-288-6816 or remove from original container and mix with used coffee grounds or kitty litter. Place in sealed container and throw in trash.
