Metro Voices - a program that features topics of state-wide and regional interest to the Denver metro area. Thornton works with the Greater Metro Telecommunications Consortium to produce this program.

Off The Page – features Colorado authors who talk about their books and the inspirations that drive them in the literary world.



Sharing Miracles - a program that features inspirational stories of well-known people who overcome illness and disease that face many Americans. The program promotes strength through sharing.

Health and Home Report - delivers a variety of stories of interest on consumer news, parenting, personal finance, household hints, health, technology, travel, business and nutrition.



Delivering Justice - from the US Post Office Investigation Division, is a series of public service advisories told in story form designed to warn people about scams carried out using the mails.

White House Chronicle - a weekly non-partisan news and public affairs program that looks at the news with a sense of fun while providing insight into current events.



NASA 360 - takes a look at NASA's past, present, and future by examining how technology is being used from space exploration to everyday consumer products.

Saving a Species – produced by Sea World, this program targets a younger audience with compelling stories about animals and global conservation issues.



The Whole Child - shows real caregivers and children working and playing together in ways that facilitate children's learning and development. It highlights teaching approaches and interactions with children of all developmental levels including those with disabilities and special needs.

Growing Old In A New Age - examines common misconceptions about aging and provides a springboard for analyzing new roles for elders, intergenerational alliances and resource allocation.



Hot and Cold - a show about home maintenance, repair and renovation as well as updating with new types of insulation and alternative energy. It illustrates how homeowners can do a lot of the work themselves or be more knowledgeable if they were to hire someone.

Green By Design - a grass roots TV series spotlighting sustainable living. Through the stories of the people who are taking action we learn the many ways we can incorporate “green” choices into our daily routine.
