New this year! Candy partners will not be allowed to perform or present at their trunk locations. If candy partners wish to perform or present their business we will have a stage available for an additional \$75 for 45-minute time slots available. Each trunk will be given four passes for children in their group wishing to trunk or treat. Any additional children will need to pay the \$1 admission fee.

Candy Contributors are those businesses or individuals who donate a minimum of \$10 in monetary or actual candy in support of this event. In return for this donation, your name or company name will be included in the Candy Contributors section of the program handout that will be made available to each participant. Candy Contributors will not be permitted to promote their business or distribute business literature on-site.
