**NWS Severe Weather Spotter Training prepares you to identify severe weather situations in your community. You'll become a strong resource within the community, providing early warning notifications to family, friends, businesses, and the National Weather Service.**

**You'll learn:** severe weather safety techniques, how topography effects atmospheric conditions, cloud types and features, thunderstorm structure, how to identify potential tornado conditions, and severe weather warning systems and information flow.

**Upon completion of the class** you'll become an official member of the Colorado All-Season Spotter Team (CAST) and receive a weather spotter identification number and instructional information on providing real-time weather reports to the National Weather Service in Boulder, CO.
